



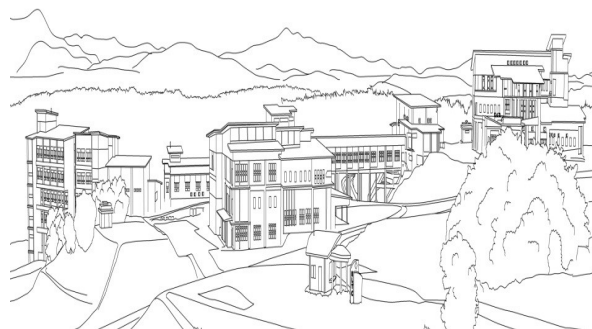

PROFESSIONAL UP-SKILLING OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHERS (Pro-ELT)

Pro-ELT

INTRODUCTION

The 2nd shift from the 11 shifts identified in the Malaysia Education Blueprint 2013 – 2025 is related to language and explicitly recognizes the role and importance of English. Shift 2 of the Blueprint (“Ensure every child is proficient in Bahasa Malaysia and English language and is encouraged to learn an additional language”) reflects the Government’s commitment to ensure that every child is proficient in Bahasa Malaysia and English Language. Aside from initiatives that focus on enhancing student acquisition of English, initiatives to enhance the teaching and learning of English also include upgrading teachers’ English language proficiency and pedagogical skills and competencies. The outcome was the Professional Up-skilling of English Language Teachers Programme or Pro-ELT for all English Option teachers who did not obtain the required minimum Level C1 according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Teachers who complete the programme are required to take a CEFR aligned proficiency tests such as Aptis, Malaysian University English Test (MUET), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), and Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVE

- To enhance the language proficiency of English language teachers.

TARGET GROUP

- 18,500 English Language option teachers who obtained CEFR Band B proficiency level in the Aptis test.

TRAINERS

- Experienced trainers who provide participants guidance and support during the face-to-face and online learning.

MATERIALS

- Course material (face-to-face and digital) designed to give participants ample practice for improving their proficiency level.

PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT

- Teachers are tested at the beginning as well as at the end so that improvement can be measured.

BLENDED MODE TRAINING

- Phase 1 : Face-to-Face Interaction
(1 week : 30 hours)
- Phase 2 : Online Tasks
(4 weeks : 60 hours)
- Phase 3 : Face-to-Face Interaction
(1 week : 30 hours)
- Total hours : 120
- Upon completion, teachers are required to take Malaysian University English Test (MUET)

REFRESHER COURSE

Teachers who are still in CEFR Band B after the programme can join the online refresher course to obtain guidance and support before taking a proficiency test of their choice.
